

# 2.1. SCOPE OF WORKS

#### **SCOPE OF WORKS/SPECIFICATIONS**

#### 2.1.1. PROJECT MANDATE

ERWAT is seeking professional services to implement the additional infrastructure improvement project of the Olifantsfontein WCW Intervention Programme that will increase the capacity of Olifantsfontein Water Care Works (WCW) while also improving process efficiencies and effluent quality.

The implementation of the Olifantsfontein WCW Intervention Programme is conducted in two (2) stages as follows;

- The **first stage**; this stage is currently undergoing and is primarily focusing on the resuscitation of Module 3.
- The **second stage**; this stage is the one currently planned to be implemented through this bid and will focus on the upgrade and rehabilitation of the all the infrastructure within the Olifantsfontein WCW (module 1, 2 and 3) and other activities that have been omitted under the first stage as a result of budget constraints.

The scope of work is of a nature of a multi-discipline engineering project that is mainly associated with Process Engineering and Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Electrical Engineering, however, the scope of services also extended to specialized works which shall include (but not limited to), Quantity Survey and Land Survey. Therefore, the service provider/s shall be required to carry out these specialized works through relevant specialists, and in the event that the service provider lacks in-house specialist capacity; then, the Service Provider shall be required to outsource such services.

The following site conditions and challenges at Olifantsfontein WCW should be noted:

- The WCW is built on a dolomitic area
- Limited available footprint for new facilities
- Most plant infrastructure and equipment are of age and have dilapidated
- Unavailability of some of the As-built drawings

#### 2.1.2. BACKGROUND OF THE WCW

#### **History of plant**

The Works was commissioned in 1972 and was based on the conventional biofilter process with a capacity of  $4.5 \, \text{M}\ell/\text{d}$ . A 9 M $\ell/\text{d}$  extension to the works was commissioned at the beginning of 1976 which was also based on the biofilter process. The estimated biological loading at the time was 6 000kg BOD/d based on an estimated population of 120 000 people equivalent (PE) and 50g BOD/capita.d. The total hydraulic capacity of the works was 13.5 M $\ell/\text{d}$ .

In 1987 the Works was modified (Phase 2). The biofilter system was capable of handling the flow of 13.5  $M\ell/d$  satisfactorily, but this flow was to be increased to 16  $M\ell/d$  with a biological loading of 8192kg BOD/d, performing as roughing filters and producing a sub- standard effluent which required further treatment in a new activated sludge plant. The combined biological treatment capacity of the biofiltration and activated sludge processes was 19 456 kg BOD/day and was able to handle a flow of 38  $M\ell/d$ .

In 1994 the Phase 3 extension (known as Module 1 and 2) was commissioned, two activated sludge plants with a capacity of 35 Ml/d each. In 1995 the rehabilitation of Phase 2 was commissioned which included the relocation of the Phase 2 activated sludge plant secondary clarifiers and related pump stations and the

construction of a new primary settling tank with elutriation, also with a capacity of 35 Ml/d. With this addition, the capacity of module 3 was effectively reduced from 38 to 35 Ml/d.

Originally, the works overall capacity was 105 Mt/d (ADWF) hydraulically, and was able to treat the following organically:

- Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD).....914 mg/l
- Suspended solids ......441 mg/l
- Total Kjeldahl Nitrogen (TKN).....64 mg/l
- Total Phosphorus (TP) ......13 mg/l

The plant has now been regraded to the following overall capacity due to tilted PST in module 3 not in use and other constraints at the plant:

#### **Plant Description**

Raw sewage is screened and degritted in the combined Inlet Works. From here flow is split to the newer Modules 1 and 2, and to the older Module 3.

#### Module 1 and 2

The flow to Modules 1 and 2 is split into two and both are measured. Both Modules 1 and 2 are identical. Flow to each Module is settled in its own primary sedimentation tank (PST). The primary sludge is screened and recycled back to the PSTs for the elutriation of volatile fatty acids (VFAs). Wasted primary sludge is pumped to the anaerobic digesters.

The settled sewage is routed to identical Biological Nutrient Removal reactors for the biological removal of COD, Ammonia and Phosphate, with its associated a-, r- and s-recycles. These BNRs are able to run in the 3-stage Phoredox, UCT, Modified UCT and Johannesburg processes. Each Module has two Separators where

suspended materials are settled out. The clarified effluent is chlorinated and routed through a Chlorine Contact Tank before being discharged to the Kaalspruit.

#### Module 3

The flow to Module 3 is measured and settled in a single PST. The primary sludge is screened and recycled back to the PST for the elutriation of volatile fatty acids (VFAs). Wasted primary sludge is pumped to the anaerobic digesters. The settled sewage is split to a biofilter system and activated sludge system.

In the biofilter system the settled sewage is sprayed or trickled over the top surface of six biological filters through which it then percolates. The biofilters are aerated by natural draft to provide oxygen to the process. A biofilm containing a large number of organisms forms on the surface of the media. As the sewage flows over this biofilm a series of complex bio-chemical reactions take place by which organic material is removed from the sewage. The organisms require oxygen and this is obtained from the air circulating in the filter bed. Hence maximum ventilation should be provided. The biofilm increases in thickness until eventually portions break away and are carried out of the bed in the effluent. This material is known as 'humus' which is traditionally separated from the effluent in six humus tanks.

According to available information, the effluent can either gravitate from the humus tank to the aeration basin of the BNR of the Activated Sludge System, or be pumped to the PST division box for recirculation during low flows. The humus sludge is collected in the humus sump and pumped to the division box of the PST.

In the Activated Sludge system the biological removal of COD, Ammonia and Phosphate, with its associated a-, r- and s-recycles takes place. The BNR can only run in the three stage Bardenpho configuration. Two clarifiers settle out suspended materials. A system of maturation ponds with a retention period of one day has been made available as a Chlorine Contact Tank, although it is not currently used as such. Chlorine dosing occurs from the Module 1 and 2 system directly into the effluent discharge channel.

In order to comply with the Special Standard for phosphates, a ferric chloride dosing facility is available for all the modules, which can be dosed at the overflow of all the BNR reactors.

## **Design Influent Flow Characteristics**

Olifantsfontein Water Care works receives a combination of industrial and domestic sewage from Tembisa, certain suburbs in the north of Kempton Park, Ivory Park including Olifantsfontein, Midstream Estate Extension 2, Western and Southern parts of Chloorkop and Esselen Park Extension among others. The total influent is 105 Ml/d (ADWF) and is distributed equally to the existing 3 Modules at the plant by a system of weirs and sluice gates at the Head of works. Extraneous inflow at the Head of Works overflows to the emergency storage ponds, and then recycled back to the Head of Works during periods of low flows.

Any excess flow is bypassed to the emergency storage ponds in order to limit the total flow to the three modules to a maximum. The bypass flow is not measured, except when the emergency storage dams are emptied by returning the flow to the inlet works and eventually flowing through the measuring flume. Consequently, no information is available on peak flow. The maximum capacity of the sewers entering the WCW is 240 Ml/d. The manholes in the sewer network will overflow whenever the flow exceeds 240 Ml/d and will not reach the WCW. The maximum capacity of the emergency bypass pipeline is 30 Ml/d.

The inflow is divided to each of the three modules, with some flexibility to control the fraction of the flow to module 3. The sluice gates in the channels after the flow division are also used by the operators to manipulate the flow to each of the modules. It was observed that the flow is backing up in the inlet works and that the measuring flume is submerged when the sluice gates are partially closed. The flow recorded in the measuring flume is therefore not reliable and will be higher than the actual flow. Any records of the diurnal flow patterns are therefore not correct. There are flow meters installed in each of the three channels. In order to compensate for the measurement error of the flow meter at the inlet works, the flow to each of the modules is recorded daily. This information is used to calculate the total daily inflow into the plant and is recorded. It should be noted that it does not contain any information with respect to peak dry weather flow (PDWF) or peak wet weather flow (PWWF).

The average and maximum design flows that can be accepted with and without the biofilters are summarized in Table 1.

#### **Sludge Disposal and Management**

The primary sludge from Modules 1, 2 and 3 is pumped to the Anaerobic Digesters 2 to 6. Digester 1 is used for storage of WAS in case of problems with the thickening and dewatering systems. The digesters are unheated; however, Digesters 1, 2, 5 & 6 are unmixed and Digester 3 & 4 are mixed. Under normal operating conditions the stabilized sludge is drawn off to the sludge drying beds and the supernatant returned to the inlet works. It is also possible to pump the stabilized primary sludge to the Belt Press (Dewatering) system.

Waste Activated sludge (WAS) is withdrawn from the aerobic zones from all three Modules and/or from Secondary Settling Tank Underflow (Return Activated Sludge (RAS)) for Module 1 and 2. This is combined with scum from module 1 & 2 settling tanks to the Dissolved Air Flotation (DAF) tanks. This sludge combination is thickened and pumped to the Belt Press (Dewatering) system. The stabilized primary sludge and WAS is combined and screened before being fed into the Belt Press system. A flocculent is dosed before the sludge is fed to the belt presses. A conveyor transports the dewatered sludge to a concrete slab. The dewatered sludge is loaded on to trucks and transported to various farmers for agricultural use. Olifantsfontein WCW Process Flow Diagram is shown below:





Figure 1. Process flow Diagram







Figure 2: Olifantsfontein WWTW Google Layout

# 2.2. EVALUATION CRITERIA

ERWAT will establish a Bid Evaluation Committee (BEC) whose responsibility it is to make recommendations to the Bid Adjudication Committee (BAC). The Bid Evaluation Committee will short list and evaluate the bid document in accordance with the criteria below and make recommendations to the BAC.

- 1. **Stage 1: SCM Pre-compliance/Administrative compliance**: All the pre-qualified bidders shall progress through to functionality evaluation. Where some SCM pre-compliance information is not provided the supply chain department of ERWAT shall contact the responsible bidder to submit within 5 working days and failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- Stage 2: Technical/functionality evaluation: evaluation shall take place in two sub stages ,namely Technical Pre-compliance and Functionality Scoring. All non-compliant bids shall be disqualified and pre-qualified bids will progress to Functionality Scoring where bids scoring a minimum of 75% points are qualified for the final stage of evaluation (i.e. Price and Preference).
- 3. **Stage 3: Price and Preference**: Scoring of all eligible Bids having progressed through the second stage of evaluation in terms of Price and Preference only, by:
  - 3.1. Confirming that that Tenderers progressing beyond the second stage are eligible for the preferences claimed, and if so,
  - 3.2. Scoring Bid evaluation points for price and preference points.
  - 3.3. As ERWAT is not certain of the total contract value of this contract, calculating the total Bid evaluation points, to two decimal places based on the Price and Preference on (90/10) system. Thus, the recommended bidders' price will determine the (90/10) scoring.
  - 3.4. Rank Bid offers from the highest number of Bid evaluation points to the lowest.




